

BAROQUE IN THE BUSH

This will be our 27th year of merry music-making in the African bush. If you weren't at Baroque last year, you missed one of our best events ever. The quality of the music was exceptional, as evidenced by several standing ovations, and the most positive feedback we've ever had.

We're almost full on all three events, but the waiting lists are very short, and there will be cancellations, so it's definitely worth putting your name down.

The dates:

Baroque 1: 20 to 23 Sept 2024, in on Friday afternoon, out on Monday morning

Baroque 2: 23 to 26 Sept 2024, in on Monday afternoon, out on Thursday morning

Baroque 3: 26 to 29 Sept 2024, in on Thursday afternoon, out on Sunday morning

The public holiday is on Tuesday 24th.

THE COSTS

- 3-sleeper hut with bathroom and kitchen: Ideal for couples, or for 3 friends sharing. R9,370 per person sharing for 2 people, R7,370 per person sharing for 3 people. Singles pay R11,560.
- 2-sleeper hut with bathroom and kitchen: R9,530 per person sharing. Singles pay R11,720.
- 2-sleeper hut with bathroom: R8,460 per person sharing. Singles pay R10,650.
- 4-sleeper hut – 2 bedrooms with en-suite bathrooms, plus indoor kitchen: R9,260 per person sharing. Singles pay R11,450.
- Camping: R5 250 per person – you'll need to provide your own tent and all other camping gear.

Costs include: Accommodation or campsite, dinner on all three nights and all concerts, talk and quiz.

Costs exclude: Transport to and from Shingwedzi in Kruger, breakfasts and lunches, drinks and other items of a personal nature. Also not included is the Kruger Park conservation fee of around R122 per person per day, which must be paid on arrival. Foreign visitors and non-residents pay R486 per person per day. Wild Card holders don't pay the conservation fee.
